As an International student residing in the United States for the purpose of studying at an institution of higher education, you are required to maintain adequate health and accident insurance coverage for the duration of your studies. The Ontario Health Insurance Program is NOT adequate insurance and supplemental insurance must be purchased. You are responsible for notifying the Registrar's Office of any changes to your Insurance coverage or eligibility. Failure to do so could result in jeopardization of your F-1 student status.

Health and Accident Insurance Information

I am an international student living in the United States and must maintain adequate health and accident insurance coverage that meets Lake Superior State University's requirements throughout the duration of my studies.

I am required to verify proof of adequate health and accident insurance annually.

Proof of health and accident insurance must be submitted to the Registrar's Office by **August 15th** for each academic year.

- A copy of my Student Assurance Services card (both sides).
