Residency requirement: students must earn at least 32 credits from LSSU & 50% of their departmental required 300/400 level credits in LSSU courses.

Students should complete MACRAO Certification at Bay College to meet LSSU's general education requirement. Check with your Bay College advisor and the Bay Catalog regarding requirements.

Applicants must be graduates of state- or provincial-approved associate's degree or diploma nursing programs with a minimum cumulative GPA of 2.7 in all nursing, nursing support and English courses. Nursing support courses include: chemistry, mathematics, anatomy and physiology, microbiology, statistics, nutrition, pharmacology, pathophysiology, computer applications in health sciences, psychology and sociology courses. Credit may be granted for nutrition and pharmacology by NLN tests and achieving scores at the 50th percentile or above. NLN tests may only be repeated once. Credit by departmental exam is also available to students upon request.

Current Michigan or Ontario professional nursing license and immunization records required prior to entry. Courses must have a grade of C or better to be transferred in to LSSU. A maximum of 32 semester hours in basic nursing courses may be transferred.

Credit for pharmacology course is acceptable for five years. Students exceeding this time may get a letter from nursing supervisor stating that medicine is being dispensed by student in current employment position.
