### REGISTRATION INSTRUCTIONS:

#### TO REGISTER THROUGH ANCHOR ACCESS:

Go to My LSSU - <https://my.lssu.edu>

Enter your user name (usually your first initial and last name, however it may also contain your second initial).

Enter your password - it is the 6 digits of your birth date MMDDYY

Don't know your User Name or Password? You can receive assistance by referring to the Student Utilities – Student Account.

\*Click on Anchor Access in the bottom right of your screen.

\*Click on Student and Financial Aid

\*Click on Registration

\*Click on Drop and Add Classes.

\*Enter the five digit CRN on the Add Classes Worksheet located at the bottom of the page. When you are done, click Submit.

\*The screen will indicate whether the class(es) have been added to your schedule.

\* If the class(es) haven't been added, it will indicate why; class is full, co-requisite is required; time conflict with another class, instructor permission required, lack of prerequisites, etc. or do a Class Search by Completing the Class Search Form, click on Class Search - Select the box in front of the CRN (C means a closed class) and choose Register or Add to Worksheet.
