## Accounting

The discipline of accounting is designed to provide financial and other information essential to the efficient conduct and evaluation of the activities of any organization. Accounting includes the development and analysis of data, the testing of its validity and relevance, and the interpretation and communication of the resulting information to intended users. Students completing the degree will be eligible to sit for various professional certification examinations. The program complies with current educational requirements for the CPA certification.

### CPA Exam Requirements:

Students requiring 150 credit hours to meet the state CPA licensing requirements will work with an advisor to select 22 additional hours which could be in the form of minors, selected courses in legal studies, CIS, law enforcement, internships, etc. An articulated advance business degree may also be an option.
