BACHELOR OF SCIENCE CRIMINAL JUSTICE

The Bachelor of Science Degree in Criminal Justice offers you the opportunity to specialize in one of three areas— law enforcement, corrections or generalist. Students selecting the law enforcement option may also be eligible for police certification under the Michigan Commission on Law Enforcement Standards (MCOLES).

The law enforcement program includes study in loss control, police operations and criminalistics. Students will be required to attend LSSU's main campus for their final academic semester. At the completion of their bachelor degree requirements, the students will have the option of attending the Skills Competition Program for seven weeks. This program is the final segment of the police academy operated by Lake Superior State University.

The Corrections Program will be offered in its entirety at Bay College's campus. It includes courses in correctional casework, juvenile justice, and an internship. This degree will benefit students entering or attempting to advance in the fields of corrections, including probation and parole.

The Generalist emphasis is designed for students currently working in the field of criminal justice and are interested in obtaining a bachelors degree to advance. This degree provides credits for academy completion and encourages students to select upper level criminal justice, business and/or management courses. All requirements for this program are offered at the regional center.

To meet the LSSU residency requirements at the regional center, students must earn at least 32 credits from LSSU and 50 percent of their departmental required 300/400 level credits in Lake State courses.
