Degree Completion Program

The Bachelor of Science Early Childhood Education is a program designed for students interested in working with children from birth to age eight. Students are expected to gain an understanding of the developmental pattern of the young child in such areas as cognition, emotion, social interaction and physical growth. This understanding will be the basis for working with groups of children and will culminate in a practicum. Students have the option of selecting either a minor in Sociology or Business.

Sociology Minor

A minor in sociology will include knowledge about social structure and human behavior. Courses in the minor include Social Psychology, Social Problems, Marriage and the Family, and Contemporary Sociology Theory.

Business Minor

This minor provides the fundamentals of business to help students gain more knowledge of different areas such as accounting, economics, finance, marketing and management. Courses include the business minor core in addition to business electives that the student may choose.
