

ACM Computer Club

Article I

The ACM computer club is a student chapter of the Association for Computing Machinery. ACM, the world's largest educational and scientific computing society, delivers resources that advance computing as a science and a profession. The purpose of the club is to allow students to share an interest in computers and computing, as well as provide opportunities to pursue this interest through competitions, conferences, and other events.

Article II

Membership to ACM computing club will be open to anyone. Officers of the club are strongly preferred to be in a computer related major.

Article III

The ACM Computer Club has 4 officer positions available.

President- Over-sees any project that the club undertakes, chair meetings, represents the club for the LSSU President's Council, and delegates tasks.

Vice President – Assists the presidential duties, and substitutes for the president when not available.

Treasure – The treasurer's duty is to keep balance of the funds for the ACM Computer Club.

Secretary – It is the duty of the secretary to take minutes for the meetings, prepare any necessary documentation and keep records.

All officers are voted into office with a majority vote.

Article IV

Meetings consist of progress reports on projects, relevant financial reports, expenses or income from fundraising/donations, and general discussion about computer related topics.
