Constitution

Article One: Name of the Organization

The name of this organization shall be the Accounting Club

Article Two: Purpose of the Organization

The Accounting Club is an organization for students in the Business program and the purpose includes the following:

- Assist students in reaching their academic and profession goals
- Provide members with a forum to learn about the different careers in the accounting field
- Promoting interaction between students, alumni, and professionals

Article Three: Selection of Officers

Officers of the club shall be active members of the Accounting Club. The election of the officers shall be on a volunteer basis. Members will gain an officer position by a majority vote of the club.

Article Four: Duties of the Officers

Officers in the club shall be the president, vice president, treasurer, secretary, and personal relations committee. The duties of the officers shall be as follows:

President

- Prepare and distribute agenda
- Preside over weekly meetings
- Represent the Accounting Club during President's Council meetings
- Approve disbursements

Vice President

- Assist the president in the president's duties
- Fulfill the president's duties in the absence of the president
- Assist in the direction of the meetings

Secretary

- Record minutes of the meetings
- Furnish members with records of meetings
- Take roll

- Maintain an accurate list of all members

Treasurer

- Collect and disburse the organization's money
- Maintain proper financial records

P.R. Committee

- Promote the accounting club to the student body
- Recruit students to join the accounting club
- Organize and conduct fundraisers

Advisor

- Be a faculty member at Lake Superior State University within the School of Business
- Serve as the advisor of the organization

Article Four: Amendments

Proposed amendments to the bylaws must be submitted in writing to the President. Voting on the bylaw will take place at the next regularly held meeting. An amendment shall be effective upon the approval of two-thirds of the regular members in attendance.
