

Constitution of the LSSU Student Chapter of Ducks Unlimited

Article I: Name

Section 1: The name of the organization shall be the LSSU Student Chapter of Ducks Unlimited.

Article II: Purpose

Section 1: The purpose of the LSSU Student Chapter of Ducks Unlimited is to conduct an annual banquet which will raise funds for Ducks Unlimited so that they can conserve, restore and manage wetlands and associated habitats for North America's waterfowl. Other goals include promoting and taking an active role in wetland conservation, and enjoying the outdoors.

Article III: Officers

Section 1: Officers serving as the Executive Board shall be President, Vice President, Secretary and Treasurer

Section 2: The Term for the Executive Board members shall be from April to April of the following year.

Section 3: Executive members must be in good standing with the institution both academically and socially.

Section 4: The Advisor shall be a member of the institution's faculty or staff.

Article IV: Membership

Section 1: Membership is open to any student of LSSU, Algoma University or Sault College, faculty, and staff members.

Article V: Election of officers

Section 1: Election of officers will occur during one of the meetings in April.

Section 2: Simple majority vote will constitute an officer election.

Article VI: Meetings

Section 1: Meetings will be held biweekly.

Article VII: Amendments

Section 1: Amendments to this constitution shall be adopted by a two-thirds vote of the members present at a regular meeting.
