

## English Club By-Laws

### Mission Statement:

- The English Club shall serve as a creative outlet to any and all students who seek to learn more about the disciplines of English. Through meetings, activities, fundraisers, and events, the students who participate will gain friendships and encouragement from fellow club members and advisors.
- The club will also provide a venue for writers to publish their material around campus through two publications.
- There will be at least two fundraisers a year
- Although the activities shall contain at the root, club members can be any student at Lakes Superior State University.
- There is no membership fee to be in the club. Membership is voluntary allowing all students to decide their level of participation.

### Composition:

- Heading up the club will be a President, Vice President, and Secretary
- The president of the club is required to run the meetings and play an active role in advertising for and overseeing the club. The president will also attend Presidents council as stated in the Presidents Council By Laws
- The Vice President is required to attend all meetings and to take over for the President if they are unable to fulfill his or her duties
- The secretary is to oversee the meetings and keep track of the business discussed. They are also key in overseeing the account information and making sure the meetings run smoothly.
