

Pep Band Bylaws

I. Official Name and Purpose

The official name of the organization will be the Lake State Pep Band, or otherwise known as the "Pep Band."

The purpose of this organization will be as follows:

- To play at all home hockey games.
- To provide entertainment at hockey games and any events to which the band is invited.
- To provide an outlet for concert band musicians to play their instruments.
- To provide a place for the musicians of LSSU to connect and network.

II. Requirements of membership

In order to join the Lake State Pep Band the following requirements should be met:

1. An instrument common of a concert band should be played, or instruments such as drum set, guitar or bass guitar.
2. One should be able to read music common to the instrument they play.
3. One should be able to attend a majority of the home hockey games the pep band is scheduled to play at.

III. Officers

The following officers are in charge of the affairs of the band:

Director: This person will be voted into office by a majority of members of the band at the end of the spring hockey season. They will be in charge of scheduling practice dates and game days, as well as making sure equipment is taking care of, contact is made with the athletic department and any fundraising money is put into the bank account. This person should also be in charge of directing and conducting the band during hockey games.

Co-Director: This person will also be voted into office by a majority of members of the band at the end of the spring hockey season. They will help the director in all capacities necessary. This person may also be in charge of conducting should the director not be able to.

IV. Meetings

The following things should happen at all pep band meetings:

1. Songs common to the pep band should be practiced.
2. New songs should be learned and practiced.
3. Information about games and practices should be passed on to the members during practices.
4. Information about fundraisers and other events should be decided with members at meetings.

V. Making Changes

Changes can be made to this document when an issue with it is brought up to the pep band as a whole, the article needing to be changed is read and a vote is taken to change it. A majority vote is needed to do that. Should a majority vote pass, the group will sit down as a whole and discuss what needs to be done to make the proper changes.
