The University has generously agreed to cover the vast majority of the renovation costs, but has asked the Chemistry and Environmental Sciences Club to raise \$10,000 to cover the costs of paint and floor coverings. We are happy to report that we have been busy fund raising and are on our way to achieving this goal, however, we could still use some more help.
