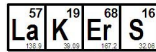

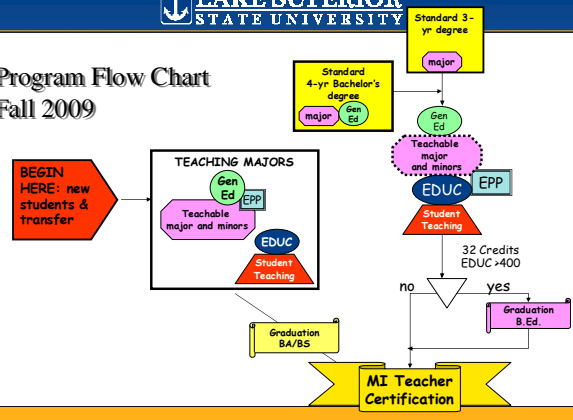

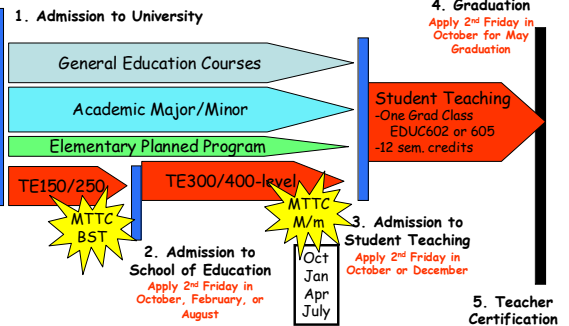

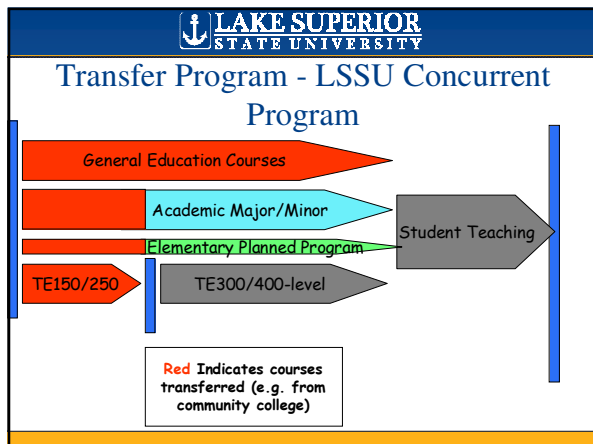
Program Flow Chart Fall 2009



"FALL 2008 - All Teaching programs"



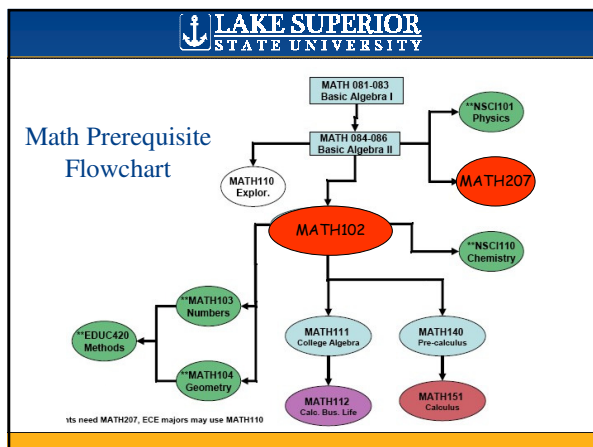

Fall 2009 - ADMISSION to School of Education

- **60 earned semester credits**
- **Required Courses MA102 or higher +**
TE150 & TE250 (B- min), EN110/111, CS101, CO101 (C min)
- **2.70 GPA w/ no grade below C (M/m/EPP)**
- **80 hrs w/ youth/children, w/ evaluation**
- **Interview, Essay, Application**
- **Must pass MTTC Basic Skills Test within first two attempts**

ADMISSION to Student Teaching

Effective for the Fall 2007*** all individuals placed into the student teaching internship MUST meet ALL of the following criteria prior to placement in a K-12 classroom:

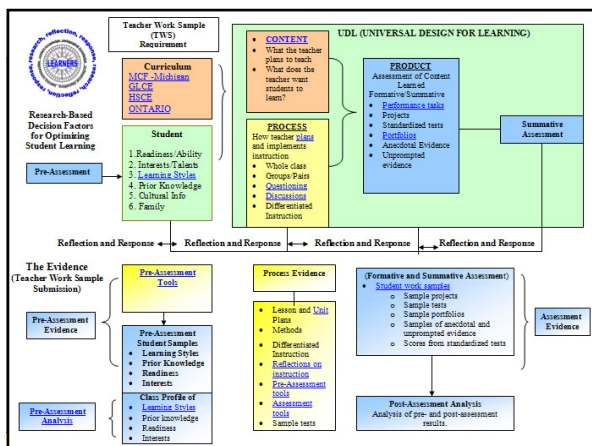
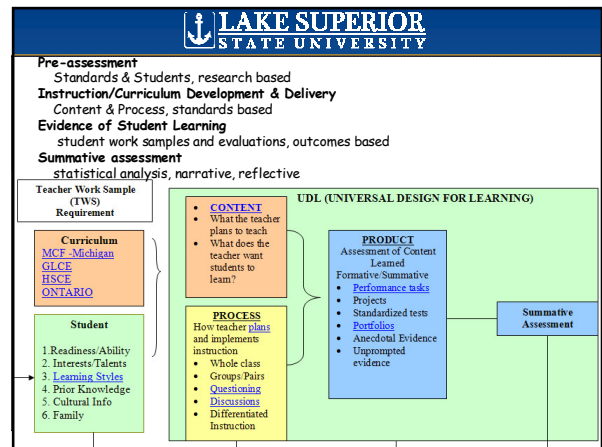
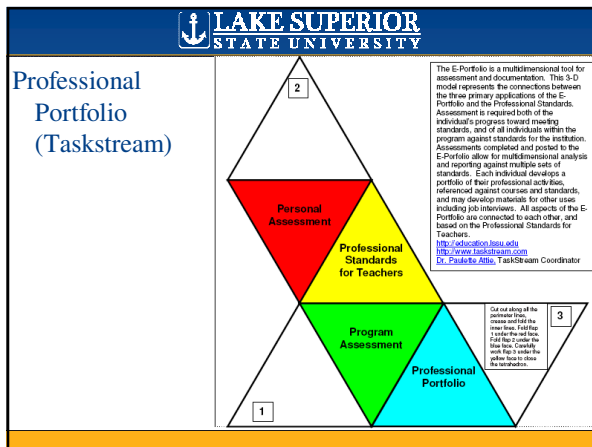
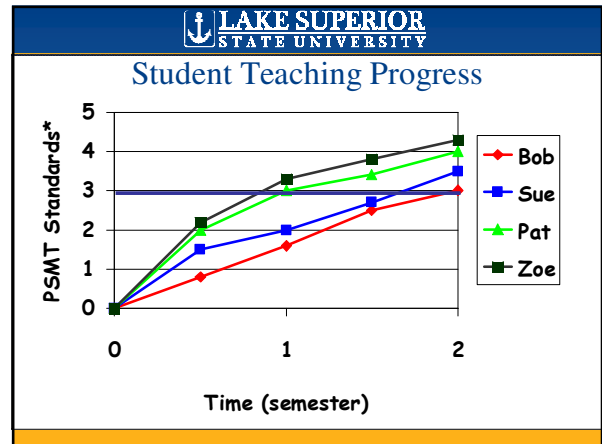
1. Completion of all required EDUC courses with grade of B- (2.70) or higher
2. Completion of required courses in the education cognates, teaching major and/or teaching minor(s) with GPA of 2.70 or higher and no grade below a "C" (2.0).
3. Completion of elementary planned program requirements with GPA of 2.70 or higher and no grade below a "C" (2.0) - elementary candidates only.
4. A candidate rating of 1, 2 or 3 on LSSU Form F365 the Pre-Internship Exit Interview
5. For the fall 2009, CSCI 101 is no longer required.

To begin your student teaching in :	The Application is due:
Start of school in August	1st Friday in December
After the Christmas break in January	1st Friday in October

Student Teaching requirements Effective Fall 2008

1. Student teaching becomes a **graduation requirement** for all teacher certification degree programs
2. "One semester" means 12 Credits: EDUC480 (1), EDUC492 (8) and either EDUC602 or EDUC605 (3). Each with grade of "B-" or higher
3. "Semester" means the university 15-week, including an extended duration of full-time, full-day, full-responsibility for classroom instruction/assessment for a period of 7-10 weeks***
4. Assessment against ELSMT using F-130, some streamlining of forms and documents
5. NEW Assessment of teacher effectiveness through assessment of student learning: Teacher Work Sample
