Congratulations on your accomplishments at LSSU, we look forward to honoring you at this special event!

1. Please arrive by 4:15 p.m. on May 4th to the Arts Center, Room 215.
 - a. Faculty and administration will also be lining up in ARTS 215
2. Wear your cap and gown and any cords, etc, that you may have.
3. The Order of March Cards will be arranged alphabetically by name on a table in ARTS215, please find yours and keep it with you as that is what you will hand the reader to announce your awards.
4. Your tassel should be on the right side of your cap.
5. There will be a program on your chair on the stage.
6. The procession will be: Mace Bearer leading students, faculty, stage party
7. Please remain standing
8. As each school is announced, the outstanding senior from that school will be called first and will read the names of their fellow classmates.
 - a. An "x" will mark the spot for you to stand so that you can hand your Order of March card to the name reader.
 - b. Once your name is announced, proceed across the stage.
 - c. If you are receiving an honor cord, you will hold your left arm out straight in front of you (closed fist) in an "L" shape so that your cord may be draped over your forearm.
 - d. If you are receiving a lapel pin, accept it with your left hand.
 - e. Use your Right hand to shake your dean's hand.
 - f. Proceed across the stage to shake additional hands and you will then be directed back to your seat.
9. Recessional is reverse order: Mace Bearer, stage party, faculty, then students.
10. A reception will follow the ceremony in the Crow's Nest.
