1) Items to bring: bug repellant, sun screen, shorts, tennis shoes, light jacket, rain jacket, long pants, as well as older clothes suitable for outdoor activities. Basically, be prepared for all ranges of weather as the weather can vary from cold, windy, wet, 50's to warm, sunny, dry 80's. Dress during the program will be casual. If your camper is participating in the Aquatics & Fisheries camp and owns his/her own waders, please bring them! We provide waders however, we cannot guarantee the correct size for your camper.

*****All students participating in science related camps must wear closed-toed shoes.*****

2) Bed sheets, pillow, blanket and a towel are provided, but you are welcome to bring an extra pillow, towel and/or small blanket. **Campers must bring their own toiletries.** A small portable fan would be a good idea in case the weather gets hot.

3) Cell phones and tablets are allowed at camp, however campers are responsible for the care and possession of their personal items. We do not allow the use of these items during academic sessions.
