

Bachelor of Science Criminal Justice - Law Enforcement Concentration w/MCOLES

This program is designed to provide a broad understanding of the criminal justice system with an emphasis in law enforcement. This emphasis prepares students for career in law enforcement and possible future promotion to supervisory and administrative positions with local, state, and federal agencies.

Students enrolled in the law enforcement emphasis may be eligible for MCOLES certification. Upon graduation and the completion of the mini-academy, these students may be eligible for employment with local law enforcement agencies in Michigan without further training. 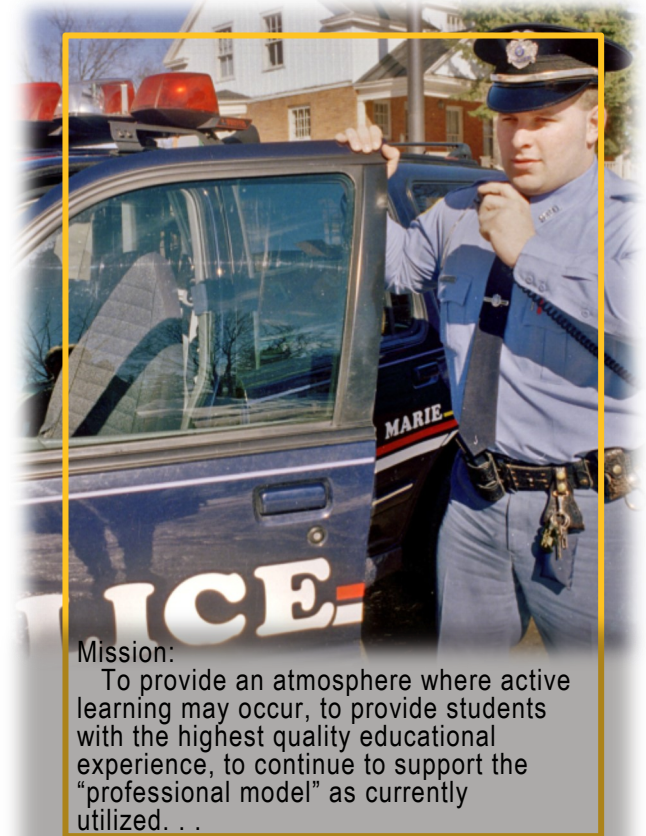
