Charter Schools Office Scholarship Fund

College is an investment for your future. Choosing whether or not to attend college is one of the most important decisions you'll make in your lifetime.

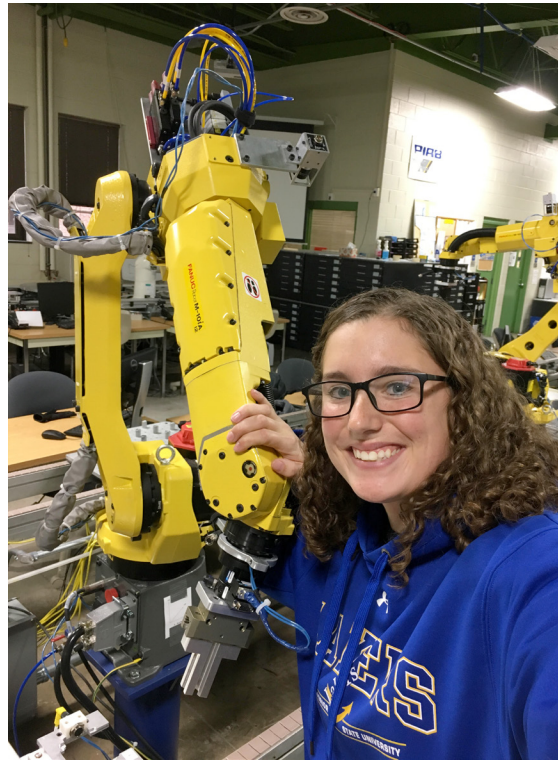
The charter school office at LSSU has established the Junior Laker Scholarship Fund to assist students considering enrolling at LSSU.

Scholarship funds help offset the cost of tuition, and room and board. The Junior Laker Scholarship is available to graduates of charter high schools authorized by LSSU.



Eligible high schools include:

Eligibility

A student must meet the following criteria to be considered for the scholarship award:

1. Be a graduate of an LSSU-authorized charter school
2. Have a cumulative grade point average of 2.5 or above
3. Based on renewal requirements and full-time enrollment.

More Information

Preference will be given to eligible students who demonstrate financial need as determined by the FAFSA form.

The scholarship is renewable for up to four years, provided the recipient maintains full-time, undergraduate status, and demonstrates satisfactory academic progress as specified by the financial aid office.

The scholarship will be distributed in even installments during the fall and spring semesters.
