Funding Priorities

The purpose of the Graymont Economic and Community Development Fund is to provide funding to organizations for small business support, assistance for schools and educators, human services, road and infrastructure improvements, conservation and enhancement of recreational opportunities, health and wellness in the Eastern Upper Peninsula. Projects serving the townships/residents of Garfield, Hendricks, Hudson, Pentland and Trout Lake will receive special consideration.

Applications can be accepted from municipalities, units of government, social agencies and other organizations, small business and members of the local community,
