A RESOLUTION TO: to urge the Lake Superior State University General Education Committee to consider alternative course options for general education credit in communication.

WHEREAS, having only one professor for communication has limited the way that COMM101 courses can be taught.

WHEREAS, by allowing students to participate in courses such as Speech and Debate, Theatre courses, among other courses that teach communication skills, students would be exposed to courses of interest that expose them to a variety of interpersonal communication skills that will support them beyond their time at Lake State.

WHEREAS, allowing such courses to fulfill the General Education requirement for communication, students would benefit more from the courses and the weight would be lightened for the Communication Department.

WHEREAS, this resolution supports LSSU Student Government Objectives 2021-2, 2021-3, and 2021-4.


BE IT THEREFORE RESOLVED, the LSSU Student Government urges the General Education Committee to consider alternative course options for fulfillment of the communication requirement.
