

2021-2022 Appeal Parent PLUS Loan Exceptional Circumstances Inability to Repay Parent Loan

According to our records, either a Parent PLUS loan on your student's behalf has been approved or you are unable to apply for the loan due to outside restrictions, but you have indicated an inability to repay the loan. Federal regulations allow the Financial Aid Office to review special circumstances that would prevent the borrower from repaying a Parent Plus Loan if the reasons can be detailed and documented.

If an appeal is granted, the student may be allowed to borrow an additional Federal Unsubsidized Loan up to \$4,000 (freshmen -sophomore) or \$5,000 (junior or higher) for one academic year only.

To appeal this issue, you must provide detailed reasons in writing as to why you are unable to secure and repay a Federal Parent Plus Loan and supply the required third party documents that support your appeal. Your monthly income/expense statement may be included to support the appeal.
