

# Equipment List for Geologic Field Work (generalized)

## For Camping...

- sleeping bag
- foam sleeping pad \*
- pillow \*
- tent ^ (a number are available through LSSU)
- ground cloth for tent \*
- flash light / Head lamp

## Personal Items...

### Clothing (for a week +)

- long pants, shorts
- belt (required to carry Brunton compass)
- long sleeve shirts, tee shirts
- plenty of socks and underwear (for a week +)
- sweatshirt(s) or sweater(s)
- sleepwear
- hiking boots – waterproof preferred
- shoes for around camp
- swimwear \* (not sure if there will be swimming opportunities)
- sun hat
- coat, warm hat and gloves \*
- rain gear (highly recommended)
- towel, washcloth, laundry bag, etc.
- soap, shampoo, shower shoes/flip-flops
- toothbrush, toothpaste, etc.
- deodorant, brush/comb, feminine products, etc.
- medications (must be in their original container with label)
- cup for hot/cold drinks \*
- cellular phone (with head phones?) \*

## For Field Work...

- day pack – to carry water, lunch, field gear, etc. (must fit under the seat in the van)
- water bottles that seal (2 quarts minimum)
- sunglasses
- sunscreen
- bug repellent
- rock hammer ^
- Brunton compass ^
- hand lens
- pocket knife \* (for testing mineral hardness, cutting fruit, etc.) \*
- small ruler w/ protractor (2 or more)
- field book + rubber bands (hard cover, water resistant paper)
- map board (11" x 11" minimum)
- mechanical pencils and eraser (hard lead – 2H recommended)
- colored pencils and black pen (waterproof ink)
- waterproof, permanent marking pen - sharpie \* (for samples)
- camera (cell phone?) \*
- reference books \* ^
