

EMPLOYEE COVID-19 Algorithm

VACCINATED EMPLOYEE with Direct Exposure*

- Monitor symptoms for 14 days. If symptoms develop, see “Development of Symptoms” below.
- For any questions, contact: humanresources@lssu.edu or (906) 635-2213.
- Recommend testing 3-5 days after exposure.
- Recommend mask wearing in indoor spaces for 14 days after exposure.

UNVACCINATED EMPLOYEE with Direct Exposure*

- Stay home and self-isolate until released by the Health Department (typically a 10-day period).
- Immediately contact: humanresources@lssu.edu or (906) 635-2213.
- Notify your Supervisor immediately.
- Get tested 3-5 days after exposure.
- If symptoms develop, see “Development of Symptoms” below.
- See “Return to Work Guidelines”.

Development of Symptoms VACCINATED or UNVACCINATED

- Stay home and self-isolate.
- Immediately contact: humanresources@lssu.edu or (906) 635-2213.
- Notify your Supervisor immediately.
- Obtain COVID-19 testing at Health Care Center (or other clinic) as soon as possible.
- See “Return to Work Guidelines”.

Tested positive for COVID-19 VACCINATED or UNVACCINATED

- Stay home and self-isolate until released by the Health Department (typically a 10-day period).
- Immediately contact: humanresources@lssu.edu or (906) 635-2213.
- Notify your Supervisor immediately.
- See “Return to Work Guidelines”.

DO NOT go directly to the Health Care Center.

After Hours: call WMH (906) 635-4460.

RETURN TO WORK GUIDELINES:

- Released from quarantine/isolation by Health Department
and
- Fever-free for 24 hours without medication
and
- Improvement of respiratory symptoms.

*Direct Exposure: exposure within 6 ft of a COVID-19 positive person for a cumulative total of 15 min or more over 24 hrs.

VACCINATED STUDENT with Direct Exposure*

- Monitor symptoms for 14 days. If symptoms develop, see "Development of Symptoms" below.

- Recommend COVID-19 testing 3-5 days after exposure.
- Recommend mask wearing in indoor spaces for 14 days after exposure.
