- Tell your donor something about yourself.

Topics you may want to include:

- Your major or area of study
- Where did you go to school before LSSU?
- Is there a particular reason(s) you chose to attend LSSU?
- Have any of your life experiences significantly affected your life and your goals?
- How you are doing in classes or what is your favorite class?
- Your hometown, background about yourself, your family, and your interests
- Future career and education goals
- The impact of receiving this scholarship.
- Include the name of the scholarship you received. - Please <u>do not thank your benefactor for selecting you</u> for the scholarship. Scholarship recipients are selected by the LSSU Financial Aid Office or <u>recommended</u> by a Selection Committee or Faculty, <u>not</u> by scholarship donors.
