EUROPEAN FROGBIT WARNING!

IDENTIFICATION

- Free floating dense mat of leaves
- Round or heart shaped leaves
- Purple or red underside of leaves
- Multiple stems connect at middle to roots
- Flower with 3 white petals and yellow middle



If you spot this plant take a picture and report its location to EGLE Aquatic Invasive Species Program



Make sure to decontaminate your equipment before leaving to stop the spread!

WHY IS IT A PROBLEM?

- Blocks paths for recreational water activities
- Dense mats get tangled in boat props
- Reduce oxygen and light in the water
- Drowns turtles
- Alters habitat and food sources for ducks, fish and aquatic mammals



LOOK A LIKES

European frogbit can also look like small water lillies. But water lillies are strongly rooted to the bottom of the water and have larger leaves
