ADDENDUM TO ARTICULATION AGREEMENT BETWEEN LAKE SUPERIOR STATE UNIVERSITY AND CENTRAL MICHIGAN UNIVERSITY

This Addendum to Articulation Agreement ("Addendum") is effective as of the date that this Addendum is fully executed (the "Effective Date"), between Lake Superior State University ("LSSU") and Central Michigan University ("CMU").

RECITALS

WHEREAS, the Parties entered into the Articulation Agreement on or about July 1, 2022, to clarify the terms and conditions for providing a seamless educational pathway from the LSSU bachelor's degree to the CMU Master of Science (M.S.) in Physician Assistant Program (PA Program), and to facilitate the acceptance of students who have successfully completed the required courses and bachelor's degree from LSSU to the PA Program at CMU.

WHEREAS, the Parties desire to amend the Articulation Agreement as set forth below.

TERMS

NOW, THEREFORE, for good and valuable consideration, the receipt and adequacy of which is hereby acknowledged, the Parties agree to amend the Articulation Agreement as follows:

1. Paragraph 1(e) of the Articulation Agreement as amended is deleted and replaced with the following:

Meet Minimum Cumulative Grade Point Average Requirement
Obtain an overall, undergraduate cumulative GPA of at least 3.4.

2. Except as amended by this Addendum, the terms of the Articulation Agreement shall remain in full force and effect and are hereby ratified and confirmed by the Parties. To the extent that any terms or provisions of this Addendum conflict with those contained in the Articulation Agreement, this Addendum shall supersede and control.
