Purpose:

The purpose of this action item is to approve promotion of Dr. Steven Johnson, Dean of the College of Arts and Sciences, to full professor.

Background:

1. According to policy 2.1.5 *Promotion Policy for Deans*, academic Deans, or their equivalent, are senior faculty by rank; therefore, promotion will address only moving from associate professor to full professor.
2. A dean who has earned their doctorate plus five years at the Associate Professor level is eligible to apply for promotion.
3. A dean prepares a Promotion File consisting of a narrative of accomplishments, report of professional responsibilities, professionally related activities, university service, and curriculum vitae, including promotion history.
4. Next, in the following order, each committee or individual recommends for or against promotion.
 - Promotions Committee, composed of all other academic Deans, or their equivalent (including Directors) on the Provost's Council, who are not applying for promotion, and the Provost.
 - Provost
 - President
 - Board of Trustees

Each of the first three levels of review has resulted in unanimous support for promotion.

Biographical Information:

Dr. Steven Johnson received his PhD in Chemistry from Michigan Technological University and his BS in Biochemistry from Northern Michigan University. He completed postdoctoral research at the University of Illinois at Urbana-Champaign and served two years as an Assistant Professor of Biochemistry at the University of New England before coming to LSSU in 2013 at that rank. Dr. Johnson was promoted to the rank of Associate Professor in 2018 and appointed as Dean of the College of Science and the Environment in 2019. In 2023-2024, Dr. Johnson was appointed as Dean of the College of Arts and Sciences.

Dr. Johnson has a strong teaching record, with positive evaluations by students. Students comment on his ability to make the material enjoyable, relatable, and understandable. They appreciate his availability, excitement, and willingness to go over material again, when needed. Dr. Johnson has continued both professional development and scholarly activities as dean. Most notably, he designed and implemented the LSSU protocols for saliva-based Covid-19 testing, which benefited our campus and community during the pandemic.

In addition to his accomplishments in the classroom and his field, Dr. Johnson's service to the University is exemplary. He has served his college through curriculum advancement and fundraising, raising over \$2.6 million in cash, pledges, and gifts-in-kind support. He has grown in his leadership through both college expansion and skill development. We are grateful to have Dr. Johnson's continued dedication to his students, field, and LSSU.

Purpose:

The purpose of this action is to request approval to execute a purchase agreement with National Bus Sales to purchase a coach bus for the Charter Schools Office to use for student visits and engagement. The purchase agreement is not to exceed \$500,000 and is to be completed by late fall 2025.

Background:

The Charter Schools Office 3% revenue will be used to purchase a coach bus with the intent of assisting our 19 charter schools, many of which primarily serve low socioeconomic students, with access to educational opportunities and programming at LSSU. When the Charter Schools Office is not utilizing the coach bus, it may be used by other LSSU Departments or other collaborative community partners, such as Sault Area Public Schools and the City of Sault Ste. Marie.

This request will not incur any costs from the general fund, but will allow the Charter Schools Office and other LSSU Departments to support growth and visibility by exposing students to LSSU's campus and programming.

Suggested Action/Motion:

Motion to approve the execution of a purchase agreement with National Bus Sales to purchase a coach bus for the Charter Schools at a cost not to exceed \$500,000. The Board further authorizes the President and/or Provost to execute all documents related to this purchase.

Purpose:

The purpose of this information is to provide an update on activities in the area of Academic Affairs.

Background:

Highlights from the Academic Affairs Monthly Updates

After the May meeting of the LSSU Board of Trustees, monthly updates have been sent to campus and the Board that contain the activities and accomplishments of our students, faculty, and staff in Academic Affairs. These reports also include upcoming events. For your reference, you can find archived copies of the monthly reports for [May](#) and [June](#) by clicking on the links. Additionally, a compilation of abstracts from student capstone projects from 2024-2025 and the Arts Center line-up of events for 2025-2026 were included with the June update.

Some highlights include:

1. On Friday, April 25, 2025, the 9th Annual Senior Research Symposium was held in the Student Activity Center of Norris Center. A total of 124 LSSU senior students showcased their research accomplishments across a wide range of disciplines. The event featured 89 individual research posters and 8 team presentations, representing 14 academic schools or programs including Biology, Chemistry, Computer Science, Creative Writing, English, Criminal Justice, Engineering, Geology, Kinesiology, Mathematics, Natural Resources, Nursing, Political Science, and Psychology.
2. All nine graduates from the LSSU Fire Science program achieved a 100% pass rate on the Michigan Firefighter 1 and 2 state exam. The Michigan Firefighter 1 and 2 state exam consists of a written portion and a practical skills portion, assessing knowledge and skills required for firefighting. The written exam covers fire science theory, emergency medical procedures, and fire safety, while the practical exam evaluates hands-on firefighting tasks.

3. All of our MCOLES graduates passed their 200 question, 3 hour written exam on their first attempt. The graduation held on Thursday, June 26, was a huge success.
4. Two students, Maggie Chism and Brady Myers had artwork accepted for this year's Art in the Legislature initiative, which is a partnership between the Michigan Association of State Universities and the Michigan Legislature to promote art in everyday life.

Dr. Jon Doubek received supplement funding to support another year of research under the USGS award titled, *Cooperative Ecosystem Studies Unit (CESU): Age-0 lake whitefish and zooplankton relations in the North Channel of Lake Huron*. This research helps to elucidate suitable nursery habitat for age-0 lake whitefish in Lake Huron, and compare age-0 lake whitefish population estimates in different regions of Lake Huron.

Led by Dr. Ashley Moerke, the annual Sea Lamprey Monitoring project will support two students over a 12-week period to assist the U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service with monitoring the migration of adult sea lampreys in the St. Marys River. The Center for Freshwater Research and Education's (CFRE) location directly on the St. Marys River allows the students to monitor traps continuously. The information collected during the monitoring period is used to estimate the adult sea lamprey population in the St. Marys River and ultimately the Lake Huron estimate, which is used to make decisions on budget and treatment allocation across the Great Lakes.

Led by Dr. Jason Garvon, the Great Lakes Piping Plover nest monitoring in Michigan's Eastern Upper Peninsula project was funded for another year of research. The Great Lakes population of piping plovers was listed as federally endangered under the Endangered Species Act in 1986. Despite modest increases in breeding pairs, the population remains extremely vulnerable to extinction due to both natural and anthropogenic disturbances. Student researchers conduct annual habitat surveys on sites known to have nesting activity (historic or recent) as well as those sites with potential habitat. It is important to identify additional nesting pairs, and to assess future management needs.

Prof. Ben Southwell manages annual water quality testing in Chippewa County. The bacterial monitoring Dukes, Kinross, and Monocle Lakes beaches provides valuable data concerning the effectiveness of surface water improvement projects and potential water quality issues that could impact swimmer safety. This monitoring program supports the gathering of vital data, providing information regarding the suitability of the lakes for swimming as well as the need for surface water improvement projects.
