Join Dr. Martin Reinhardt and Tina Moses as they share an overview of their experiences as participants in multiple research projects focused on Indigenous foods in the Great Lakes Region.

The overview will highlight insights gained from: the Decolonizing Diet Project, a traditional foods ecological knowledge study, an analysis of treaty food provisions, and a pseudo-scientific investigation of Indigenous materials and methods used for pooping. They will further explain how these experiences continue to inform their ongoing efforts in the area of tribal food sovereignty and their personal relationships with food.
