Postsecondary Credit Agreement

This Postsecondary Credit Agreement is made and entered into as of April 1, 2025, by the Michigan Department of Education (MDE) and Lake Superior State University. The agreement is for state-approved secondary career technical education (CTE) programs. Separate agreements should be submitted for each state-approved CTE secondary CIP Code number.

Purpose of this Agreement:

- 1) Expand educational opportunities for high school students, allowing them to earn postsecondary credits.
- 2) Eliminate unnecessary duplication of course materials and instruction.
- 3) Maximize the use of resources for students to complete programs as efficiently as possible.
- 4) Support postsecondary enrollment, retention, and completion.

General Conditions & Requirements:

1. Candidates must have completed the state-approved Michigan CTE program described in this agreement.
Candidates are required to meet minimum performance standards, which include:
 - a. Minimum grade of 'B' {3.0 on a 4.0 scale) or better in all CTE required courses.
 - b. Completion of two full high school credits in the designated CTE program (two hours in one year or spread out over two years).
 - c. 90% or higher time in attendance during the program.
 - d. Completion of state assessments with a passing score, if applicable, or other end-of-course exams, portfolios, etc.
 - e. Positive recommendations from the program instructors and CTE director.
2. Candidates must submit a completed LSSU Application for Articulated Credit, and all additional necessary documentation related to the successful completion of the CTE program.
3. Within two (2) years of their high school graduation, candidates must be admitted to LSSU and successfully complete (earning a 'C' (2.0) or higher) TEAC101: Becoming a Teacher (or



other approved Freshman Seminar course) before receiving articulated credits based on their CTE program.

- 4. College tuition will not be charged for the articulated course(s) listed in this agreement; no grade will be recorded.
- 5. CTE program must cover the state-approved curriculum for CIP 13.0000.

Aligned Postsecondary Courses:

Credit for students is approved for the following course(s) based upon the passage of the relevant CTE course/program or corresponding credentialing exams. All conditions and requirements must be fulfilled.
